So, Green Lib Dems have taken a bold initiative to replace those `lost` meetings with a special "One-day Conference" to be held in London at the National Liberal Club on Wednesday 12th October, in the Lady Violet Room.

Support and co-branding – Sustainability Hub and ALDC

The event has been organised by the **Green Liberal Democrats** with support from Sustainability Hub, with funds from Cadent, who were going to support one of our fringes. The venue (& virtual link)
