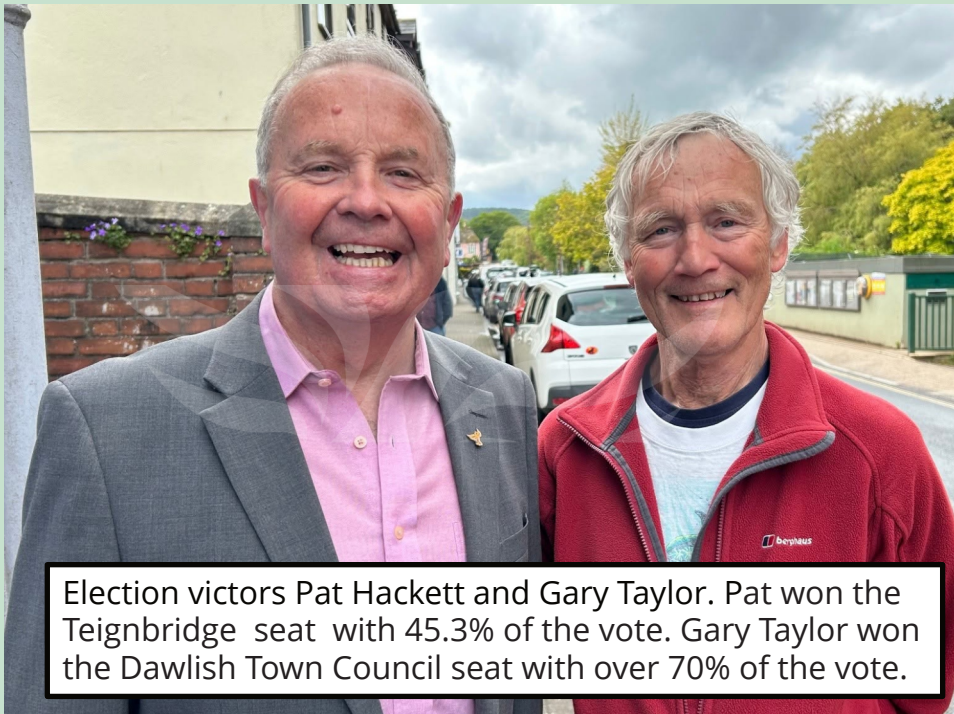

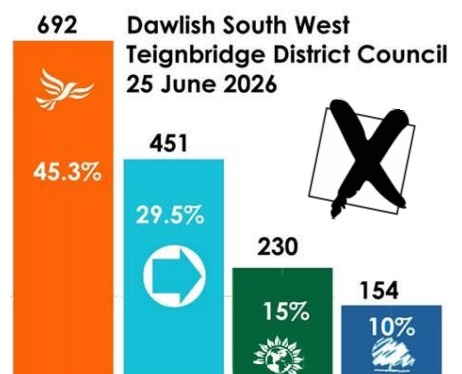

Working for Dawlish



Martin Wrigley MP has welcomed more children getting Free School Meals.

After pressure from children's charities and Liberal Democrats in Parliament, the government has announced an extension of Free School Meals to all children whose parents claim universal credit.

Dawlish Liberal Democrat Teignbridge councillor Pat Hackett said, "This is extremely good news and something Liberal Democrats have been campaigning for.

"The change will improve

children's nutrition, performance in school, and help families struggling in the cost-of-living crisis."

Councillor Rosie Dawson, said: "I supported Devon County Council to auto-enrol all children who are eligible for Free School Meals. A move which has helped thousands more children with a free meal at lunchtime."

Rosie's Road Work

After 18 months of SWW and Wales and West upgrades, Rosie has been speaking to utility companies, Highways and residents to push for less disruption and more communication.



She has also liaised with Powderham and other events organisers to ensure future traffic management plans consider the coastal area more, especially commuters who need to get home after a long day at work.

Rosie successfully got one utility company to man their light set up seven days a week after initially planning to remotely manage which resulted in waits of 45 minutes plus

"These upgrades are necessary to maintain supplies to homes but number one priority for these companies must be limiting disruption".

Rosie has also worked with the neighbourhood highways officer to get patching done across the parish with more improvement works scheduled.
